



Ever since I started this company Vetri Engineers, I have been focusing mostly for export as we Indians are really lagging export despite of Indian economy GDP growth was better. The poor show for export is one side due to limited support from Govt authorities but the other side is our own NRIs and Indian origins who are settled in out side India are not interested to promote Indian export unlike Chinese origins / NRCs settled in outside China who are taking consistent efforts in promoting Chinese products to every part of the world.

If you really compare between India and China, China's export is 7.12 times over India and globally China's export is more than any other country.

The only silver line for attraction towards India is many countries aversion towards China due to the Corona spreading to the world damaging the welfare of people and economy. A comparison is made between India and China's export in 2019 which reflects 90 % of export is dominated by China leaving very little for India. Now it is the time for the Indian exporters to make use of the opportunity to export more quality Indian products and services, thus creating a better economy.

During this corona lockdown we, Vetri Engineers have identified this situation a welcome opportunity to find customers around the world to supply products and services in industrial engineering areas and started getting the business in comparison with china pricing.
