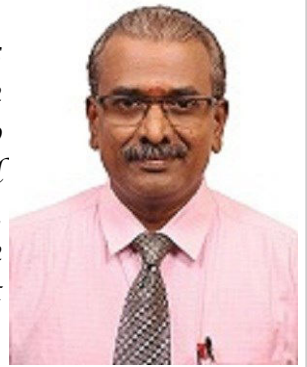

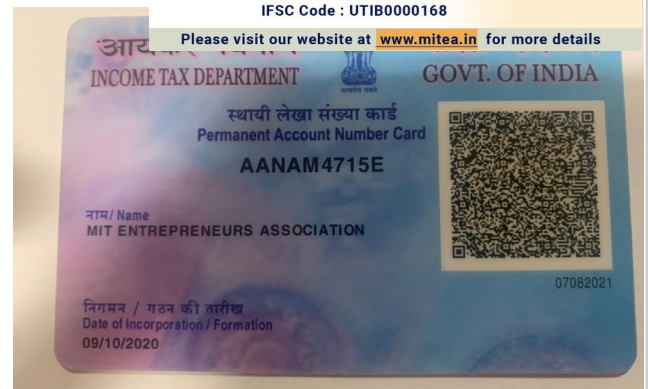

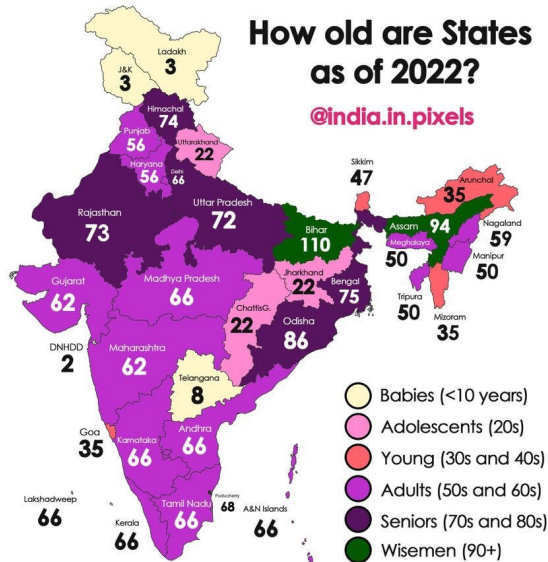

## Slippery Sleep...

A story by Mr. SV Raman, 23rd Batch IT, Settled in Bangalore



**My stay in Kauvery Hospital - Arcee**  
: A visit to a hospital is an experience in itself. Let me share my

experience in Kauvery Hospital last month as an inpatient. When I landed in the hospital 6th floor on a warm Tuesday in the month of April, the entire floor was bustling with activities. Nurses busy attending to patients, some of them accompanying doctors for ward rounds, some busy checking the inventory, and some helping patients who needed Physio therapy, or going in for procedures. The liberal staff strength in the that ward gave an impression that the hospital believes in personal nursing care.

I also had an opportunity to go round the general ward, surgical ward and medical ward. I observed doctors listening to patient's agonies sympathetically and answering their queries patiently. These are simple ways to build trust while communicating with the patients. The patient will never care how much you know, until they know how much you care.

I came back to my room only to find the nurse waiting for me to do the necessary pre operative preparations before I was taken to the operation theatre for a minor surgery.

The Anaesthetist received me with a smile in the ante room. The surgical and nursing team made sure all parameters were normal before the induction of anaesthesia. The procedure under general anaesthesia lasted about 45 minutes. I regained consciousness after a few minutes while in the post-operative care. In about an hour's time, I was in my room, sitting up to read the day's newspaper!

The surgical consultant visited me and declared that I could go home, and everything was fine. The admin staff made sure that all the papers were ready in time, and the discharge procedure was very smooth and fast. (In most corporate hospitals, this is the most harassing procedure). Special mention has to be made about the department of Dietetics; they make sure to take care of patient's needs and also the attendant. A neat rooftop cafe is on the sixth floor, offering a cool view of the eastern skyline of Mylapore.

I wish to thank the entire team of Kauvery Hospital, both medical and administrative, for making my experience pleasant.

After 60, my ability to sleep quickly got drastically eroded. So I requested my doctor to prescribe sleeping pills, which he refused, asking me to find many safer alternative solutions. That's what I did. A sleep specialist advised "If you fail to fall asleep within 22 minutes of going to bed, then move out, read a book. Return to bed only when you feel sleepy". "Yoga Nidhra is a solution" claimed a yogi on YouTube. But learning it was tougher than being awake. My wife gave warm milk before but that increased my trips to the washroom. A neighbour cautioned "Don't remain awake till midnight just to become the first person to wish everyone 'Good Morning', in your What's App groups". I lost many friendships when I did that. My daughter reminded me "Appa, try the time tested idea - count sheep". As I am a stickler to our culture, I did it with stray cows on streets, but just when I was about to complete, a truck with the sign 'Horn Ok' would appear from nowhere and drive the cows as well as my sleep away.

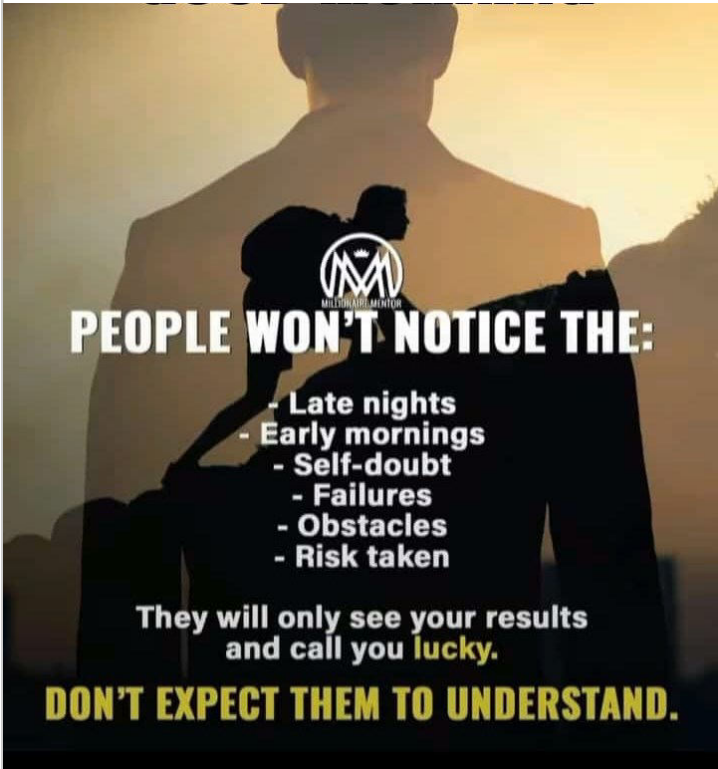

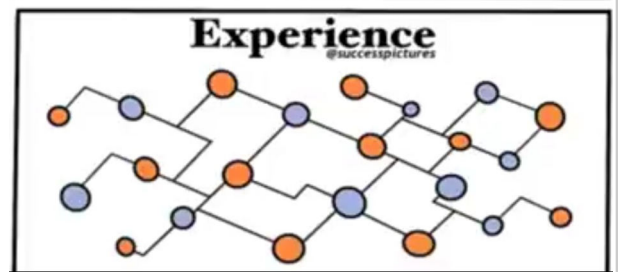
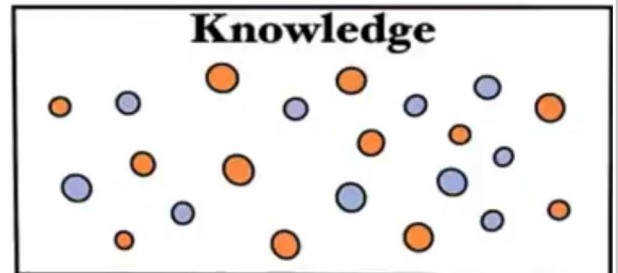
