State-of-the-art hypersonic vehicles by 2024-25: Defence Ministry

'Aero-engine components manufacturing unit coming up at Hosur'

High-end hypersonic [glide] vehicles that can cross Mach 6 and 8 are expected to be developed by 2024 or 2025, Kailash Kumar Pathak, Director of Futuristic Technology Management under the Defence Ministry, said here on Wednesday.

Speaking on the sidelines of the Coimbatore Defence Conclave 2022 at Kumaraguru Institutions, Mr. Pathak said that various programmes are coming up for dealing with extreme cold conditions for jawans, including developing new jackets for them. Multiple indigenous agencies have come together with academia for development of these.

The conclave was held to mark the seventh death anniversary of former President A.P.J Abdul Kalam.

A plaque for the new Coimbatore regional centre of the Aerospace Industry Development Association of Tamil Nadu (AIDAT) was unveiled by S. Christopher, AI-

DAT Chairman and former DRDO Head.

B. Krishnamoorthy, Project Manager of Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation (TIDCO), said an aero-engine components manufacturing unit was coming up at Hosur. The State plans to set up a semiconductor fabrication plant in association with IGSS Ventures, a Singapore-based technology investment holding company.

"The space sector economy forecast is targeted at \$

700 million by 2030," he said.

"The Defence Ministry envisions manufacturing ₹1,75,000 crore-worth items and ₹25,000 crore export under the Aatma Nirbhar Bharat [Abhiyan]. Tamil Nadu, which houses the largest industries, can contribute to a major chunk of this and Coimbatore can help further this goal," he said.

"We have identified various theme-based parks to cater to the needs of Indian Space

Research Organisation facilities like manufacturing launch vehicles and for fabrication," he added.

"Roughly only 50% of the total trained pilots required for the country is sent from Tamil Nadu. To develop a new aviation training facility, over four foreign firms have inked MoUs with the State. TIDCO is in the process of identifying and developing airstrips for this facility. We are in talks with various foreign agencies and Indian Offset Partners (IOP) under the Defence sector so that Tamil Nadu can hit the projected \$1 trillion economy," Mr. Krishnamoorthy said.

Anna varsity tables revised syllabus

It is for the second, third and fourth year students

After a massive exercise that involved industry experts and academicians for over two months, Anna University tabled the 2021 Regulations for second, third and fourth year students at the Academic Council meeting.

The college principals, who attended the meeting, said the university had stacked up courses in a cluster in what they called “verticals”. Each department



ing, a student opts for Internet of Things, then by choosing a set of courses that go along in that cluster, the student has the opportunity to become a specialist in IoT,” said a member.

Minor degree

By taking a set of 18 credits

ter in what they called “verticals”. Each department will have a set of verticals which will include elective courses. Students can choose their professional electives.

For instance, a student of Mechanical Engineering would have courses such as product and process development; modern mobility system; robotics and automation; digital and green manufacturing; processed equipment and piping design, clean and green technology; computation engineering; logistics and supply chain management; additive manufacturing; and AR and VR in manufacturing. Each course will have such clusters.

The university has proposed to introduce skill development courses in each semester.

“A student who takes these courses and the skill development programmes can expect to become a technical expert in the subject. If, for instance, in Computer Science and Engineer-

Minor degree

By taking a set of 18 credits in a particular subject, a student will earn a minor degree in the subject. Similarly, a student who takes 18 extra credits after the third semester and maintains a CGPA of 7.5 throughout the degree programme without a history of arrears, will be awarded Honours degree.

The new regulation would be demanding and students would have to spend more time, point out the teachers.

The skill development courses that are added to each semester was a good move as the students will compulsorily have to develop themselves, point out teachers.

The university has proposed to launch foreign languages such as German and Japanese. Also students would have to compulsorily learn English as a language. The laboratory component includes students having to listen to conversations and respond to questions.

Editorial of Dinamani about the Inauguration of Madras Institute of Technology

A GOOD BEGINNING

It was a great effort to establish a high quality professional education Institute yesterday at Chromepet near Chennai. The aim of this Institute is to select best Science and Engineering graduates and provide practical knowledge to make them experts in their professions. Ordinary Science and Engineering studies will be useful to know the scientific ideology only. There is always a complaint that the experiences gained in Engineering colleges during studies are not enough to work in Industries with the focus on Research. These graduates are not able to visualize how these basics and theories of Science and Engineering learned during their course are applied in Industries. The aim of this Institute (MIT) is to overcome this by providing total professional experience. Presently people are going abroad for this type of education. Apart from rich people others are not able to provide such an opportunity to their children. There is no doubt that everyone will welcome such an educational facility here.

Establishing this type of Institutes in many will help in the development of our Industries. We are going to involve now in full swing for the development of Industries. Initially we may need the help of some foreign experts. Unless we get our people with enough education and experience to replace them as quickly as possible it will be difficult to achieve fast industrial growth.

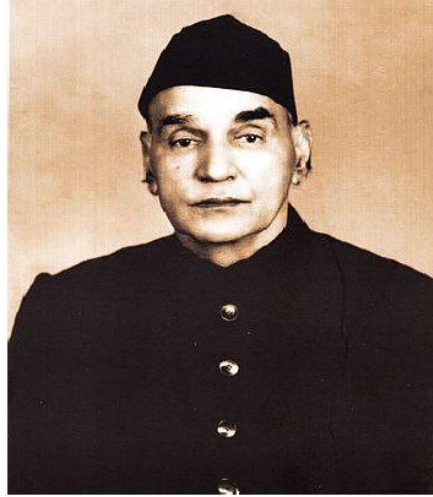
Presently there is a setback in irrigation projects due to shortage of Engineers and Overseers. This should be a warning to us. After opening the industries we should not worry about the non-availability Engineers. To fulfill this need at least partially MIT a professional education institute is starting today and it is the duty of Government and Industrialists to cooperate with this Institute. On behalf of Madras Presidency Prime Minister Shri.Raja promised his support. It is also expected that Indian government will extend all helps for the development of this Institute.

The donation of Rs.5 Lakhs from a South Indian Industrialist Shri.C. Rajam was the main reason for the effort to establish this Institute. Following him many other Industrialists also donated for this cause. But this Institute needs annually Rs.10 Lakhs for another ten years for its development and then require annually Rs.3 Lakhs for maintenance. We hope Industrialists will donate annually for this cause from their income. We hope that State and Central governments will cooperate for this cause by providing required timely help.

Born: 11 November 1882 Swamimalai, Thanjavur, Tamil Nadu

Died: 21 July 1955 Chennai

Shri Chinnaswami Rajam was born on 11th Nov. 1882, in the village of Swamimalai, near Kumbakonam. He had his High School education at the Town High School, Kumbakonam. Till 1904, he was staying at Kumbakonam, searching for a job. In 1904, he joined the Salem Government Weaving School, and learnt the art of weaving. Then he started his own handloom factory at Salem with a capital of Rs.1,000/- and manufactured dhoties, towels, shirtings etc., with fly-shuttle looms. After that, Shri Rajam tried out his hand in many jobs like grocery shop, canvassed orders for a tannery firm, managed a leather goods show room etc.

He started the Kumbakonam Electric Supply Corporation Ltd. in 1932, and the Nagapatam Electric Supply Company Ltd. and Indian Steel Rolling Mills Ltd. in the year 1933, and these companies had flourished very well. The paid-up capital of these companies exceeded Rs.50 lakhs. He was the chairman of five companies, India Company Pvt. Ltd., Kumbakonam Electric Supply Corporation Ltd., Nagapatnam Electric Supply Company Limited, Indian Steel Rolling Mills Limited, and Garage Limited. The initial paid up capital of these companies was more than Rs.50 lakhs at that time. He was also in the Car Agency. In those days in cities and towns, distribution of electricity was handled by private

companies. Sri Rajam's companies handled them well and outages were rare in those days. He was described as a "Pioneer in the Industrial Field" by the late Dr.C.P. Ramaswami Iyer.

During one of his visits to his steel factory at Nagapatnam, Shri.C Rajam realized he had to depend on German engineers to fix certain technical snags in the machinery and it did affect the productivity of his company. This made him to think about the scarcity of well-qualified Indian engineers in those days due to lack of adequate engineering colleges. Not to depend on foreign engineers and to make well qualified engineers in India, he decided to start an Engineering College which gave more emphasis on practical knowledge than theory so that the students from this institution could handle the job in the workshop or factory with confidence. For establishing this engineering College, he sold his two bungalows and gave a donation of Rs.5 lakhs to start "THE MADRAS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY." For this effort he was well supported by his friends M. Subbaraya Aiyar, M. K. Ranganthan, K. Srinivasan, C. R. Srinivasan, and L. Venkatakrisna Iyer. Thus "THE MADRAS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY" was born on 18th July 1949.

In a well thought plan the Institute started with four different courses Aeronautical Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Electronics Engineering, and Instrumentation Engineering, a bold deviation from teaching Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering etc., and students from all over India were admitted to the Institute and the MIT Campus was looking like mini-India in those days. True to his vision most of the students graduated from this institution became successful in their respective professions and many of them held responsible positions in the government, public sector, defense, and private industries.

During the first convocation of MIT on October 9, 1952 the first prime minister of India Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru highlighted the efforts by the founder and his companions, "Anyhow, the most impressive fact of this young and growing institute is that you, having started from small beginnings, are making good progress more with your own efforts, than what you could have if you had an easier time, having all things put before you".

In 1978 MIT became part of Perarignar Anna University of Technology (PAUT) along with other constituents' colleges, College of Engineering Guindy, AC Tech College, and School of Architecture and Planning. Then the degree was offered as B.Tech instead of B.Sc, DMIT. Later PAUT becomes Anna University. Now

this institution offers 4-year degree courses in engineering after +2 qualification and the 3-year diploma course (DMIT/B.Tech) offered after B.Sc. degree in Mathematics or Physics or Chemistry earlier was done away with.

With all these changes which are inevitable Madras Institute of Technology (MIT), carrying out tirelessly the vision of its Founder Shri. C Rajam and producing high class Engineering graduates. It is very much satisfactory to observe the progress of the Institute for the past 73 years which started with 4 branches of engineering and now have many new undergraduate and post graduate courses in various Engineering subjects.

The uniqueness of this Institute is various Alumni associations in India, abroad and MITAA parent chapter in Chennai extend their help in building infrastructure in MIT campus and assist passing out graduates to get employments. Also, a large amount of scholarships are provided to the students to help them to overcome financial burdens.

Madras Institute of Technology is progressing in proper direction for the past 73 years according to the dream and vision of its Founder Shri C Rajam in producing Engineering Graduates ready to serve the industries. Another great thing is it also produced many Entrepreneurs in various fields who are contributing to the country's growth and providing employment opportunities to the youths of this country.

Overall Madras Institute of Technology and its Alumni fulfilled the vision of its Founder Shri. C Rajam and it will continue to serve the students and the country in future also.

TIMELINE OF HISTORIC INVENTIONS IN ENGINEERING IN 20th AND 21st CENTURY



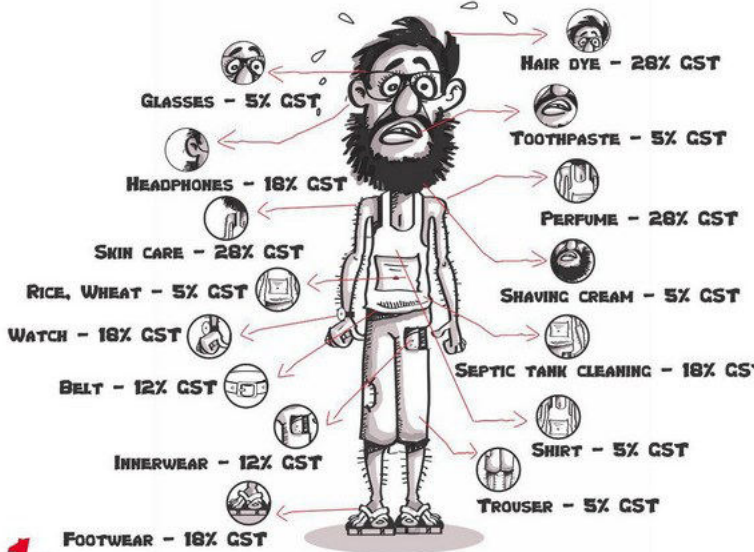
