THE HOUSE OF TATAS

It was set up in 1868 by Jamsetji Nusserwanji Tata. Sir Dorabji Tata, his son, succeeded him in 1904. When he died in 1934, he was succeeded as chairman of the group by Sir Nowroji Saklatwala. After his death, JRD Tata took over as chairman. He would lead the Tata Group for the next 53 years, till Ratan Tata took over in 1991. Cyrus Mistry, brother-in-law of Ratan Tata's half brother, Noel, will take over as chairman in 2012.



Wah Taj Wah!

This story makes me feel very proud of the Taj Mahal Hotel, Mumbai.

I want to share an experience at the Taj Mahal Hotel which taught me a lot on customer centricity.

Many many years ago, soon after

we had got married, Shruti, and I along with a friend of Shruti went for a late night movie at the Regal Cinema.

After the movie, as was our practice in those days, the three of us went to 'Shamiana', the Coffee Shop of the Taj, for a meal.

The meal was over and we were presented with the bill, and I gave the waiter my credit card. A couple of minutes later, I saw the waiter in a discussion with the manager, and they kept glancing at us. Soon after the bill came, I signed the bill and left.

Next evening, at around 6 PM I got a call. It was the waiter who had served us the previous evening. He had called up to say that the credit card I had presented the previous evening was not valid as it had expired, and he very politely requested me to settle the bill preferably cheque, if not cash.

I immediately checked and found that he was right, having received my replacement card, I had forgotten to destroy the invalid card, and had inadvertently used it the previous night. As my office was just down the road from the Taj, I agreed to settle the bill the next day when I went to work, but out of curiosity I asked him why did he not tell me all this when I was present in the hotel.

His reply floored me.

He said "since you were with two ladies I did not want to embarrass you. I recognised you as a regular patron so I took the decision of settling the bill with the manager. I told the manager if the bill was not settled within two days, then I would pay from my salary."

I could not believe what I had heard.

When I settled the bill, I wanted to give him a handsome tip. It was very politely and firmly refused.

This is what makes Taj the Taj.... This happened much before, almost 20 years before the terrorist attacks took place. This has been the culture there for over 100 years.


In this article we will study about what are Indicators and few examples of Indicators used in Technical Analysis.

WHAT ARE TECHNICAL INDICATORS

Technical indicators are used to see past trends and anticipate future moves. They are nothing but mathematical computations plotted as lines on a price chart that aid traders in identifying certain signs and trends in the stock market. They are simply a set of tools applied to a trading chart to demystify the market and make a clearer analysis.

MOVING AVERAGE (MA)

The moving average, also known as Simple Moving Average, is a price trend indicator that balances the price data by providing regular updates of the average price. The MA indicator plots a trend line, thereby wiping out any noise by random price surges. Below is a simple strategy using moving average.

MA'ss help traders identify trends and form a key part of their trading methods. If the current price is above a moving average, it signals that long bets should be considered; however, if the price action is below the moving average, it implies that you can consider short bets.

Using moving averages to identify which side of the market to trade on any specific day may be a quick and straightforward approach. There is no guarantee when it comes to using technical indicators in financial markets. Moving averages, however, may be extremely effective as a trading method when coupled with other trading indicators. Moving averages also act as good support and resistance. Below is a simple strategy using moving average

Moving averages also act as good support and resistance.

MOVING AVERAGE CONVERGENCE DIVERGENCE (MACD)

MACD detects changes in momentum by comparing two moving averages. Levels of support and resistance can help spot possible buy and sell opportunities.

When two moving averages diverge, they are said to be convergent; when they converge, they are said to be divergent. This implies that momentum is decreasing when moving averages are converging, but increases when moving averages are diverging.

This is a type of oscillating technical analysis indicator that swings inside a band over time (above and below a centerline; the MACD fluctuates above and below zero. The MACD indicator can be used for both trend-following and momentum purposes. The MACD lines must be above zero for an extended period to indicate that the stock is likely to increase.





WHAT IS THE RELATIVE STRENGTH INDEX?

When it comes to overbought and oversold stocks, the big question is not 'if' but 'when'. The timing of your entry and exit is what matters as it can allow you to either realize profits or losses. The Relative Strength Index answers the question of ideal entry and exit points for investors.

The Relative Strength Index (RSI) is another oscillating indicator that traders use to assess market momentum, market conditions, and warning signs for potentially hazardous price changes. Its value spans from 0 to 100. An oscillator helps the trader to identify whether the particular stock or contract is overbought or oversold. Generally, an asset reaching the 70 levels is considered to be overbought, whereas an asset around the 30 levels is considered to be oversold by the market.

The year, 1906. Jamsetji Tata, founder of the Tata group, had passed away two years earlier. His dream of providing India its first integrated steel plant was still work in progress. One big challenge ahead - significant capital would have to be raised.

Jamsetji's son, Dorabji Tata, had now taken over as Chairman. He went to England trying to raise capital for the proposed steel plant. However, English capitalists were wary of sending their money into India. Dorabji Tata returned, utterly disappointed. Would the steel project have to be abandoned, for lack of capital?

Dorabji decided that to ensure the steel venture took birth, he would raise the funds in India itself. This was a very bold decision. Such large sums of money had never before been raised domestically, for an Indian venture. Many people predicted failure. And failure would have impacted the Tata group hugely.

But Dorabji's belief in his country took over. He was determined to do this for India, and he worked ceaselessly to make the case for investment in Tata Steel. Then, on 27th August 1907 (which was also his birthday), he launched in Mumbai a formal prospectus for raising capital for the Tata Iron & Steel Company (see picture below).


This was a milestone day for India - an IPO for the largest start-up of the day. The first of its kind in the country. Would it succeed?

Led by Dorabji's energetic efforts, the response from Indians was electrifying. An observer wrote - "From early morning till late at night, the Tata offices in Bombay were besieged by an eager crowd of native investors. Old and young, rich and poor, men and women,

they came, offering their mite...". Indians who believed in their country, placing trust in an Indian enterprise.

Within three weeks, over 8,000 people had subscribed to this issue, and over Rs. 23 million had been raised. This was an unbelievable sum of money being raised in Indian capital markets at that time. India's first major IPO for an industrial enterprise had been a splendid success !

Later, Dorabji Tata was to write - "For the first time in India's financial history, I had succeeded in raising for industrial purposes such a vast sum from the hidden wealth of In-



dia for the development of our mineral resources. It was the first time that the raw materials of India did not go out and return as finished articles to be sold in the country. Above all, it was a purely Swadeshi enterprise, financed by Swadeshi money and managed by Swadeshi brains."

On 27th August, 2022 we marked the 163rd birth anniversary of Sir Dorabji Tata, the man who made this happen. When we speak of IPOs today, let us hark back to this pathbreaking swadeshi IPO of Tata Steel, 115 years ago. An act of courage by a legendary leader, based on the belief that we Indians have in our own country.

The Great Teacher turned Entrepreneur...Prof.S. Renganathan

Prof. S. Renganathan



A good teacher can teach you something that you will remember for a day, but a great teacher will teach you something that you will remember for the rest of your life. Truly Prof. S. Ranganathan is a great teacher! He taught us Control Systems, Process Instrumentation & Computer Science.

"Should you put hard work in the next three years, you will be happy for the next 30+ years of your career!" was his opening advice for us in the class.

He is too good in establishing a functional relationship between variables in Process Instrumentation class. This habit enabled him to define Career Success as a function of Knowledge + Skill + Attitude with 20%, 20%, 60% weightage respectively.

We enjoyed his Process Instrumentation class very much as he gave thumb rules for many characteristics, such as temperature vs mV characteristic of K-Type Thermocouples is 40 μ V /°C.

Process Control was taught by Prof. Santhanam & I was not clear about derivative action in PID Controller. When I consulted Prof. SR he smiled & asked me to imagine that I am driving my scooter at 60 KM /hr speed in a straight road & see a dog crossing the road 20 m ahead. Now he asked me to describe my reaction. I told I will apply the break. He continued what you will do after seeing the dog crossing the road. I told I will leave the break & increase the acceleration. He told that is exactly the derivative action. Then I never forgot derivative action.

It didn't matter what our mood was before we walked into his classroom, because he always brought smile to our faces. He demonstrated kindness and patience to each and every student in his class.

Another important thing that he had taught us was to believe in ourselves. When a teacher believed in you, you cannot help but work even harder, which only leads to success. I believe that throughout the rest of my life, I am demonstrating the same great qualities that I found in him.

He used to flash many golden motivating messages during face to face discussions such as

- Success swells your head & failure weakens your heart, when you fail to learn from them!

- One small crack does not mean that you are broken; it means that you were put to the test and you didn't fall apart.
- Just breathe! You're strong enough to handle your challenges, wise enough to find a solution to your problems, and adequately capable of doing whatever needs to be done.

He has been an exemplary role model, and has taught me to have many strong traits.

Even after leaving MIT, I kept in touch with Prof. SR to enjoy the positivity spread by him. Few of the memorable interactions I had with him after leaving MIT could be summarized as below:

- In early 1991 IEEE Madras Section requested me to deliver a talk in one of their seminars. At that time I had visited & signed a MoU with Samsung, South Korea for Transfer of Technology to make UPSS up to 1000 KVA in India. As this subject was fresh in my memory, I preferred to talk on 'Power Devices in Higher KVA UPS'. Before me in that seminar Prof. SR delivered a great talk on "Transducers Application." He appreciated my talk.
- In middle 2000, I had an opportunity to talk on 'Evolution of Electronics' at MIT in the Inter College Program organized by ISA. Prof SR was the Chairman of ISA South India Chapter & he presided over this function. He encouraged my talk freely.
- In April 2003, I had an opportunity to participate in a Seminar organized by ISA South India Edison at Pondicherry & I delivered a talk on 'Virtual Instrumentation.' I understood Prof. SR recommended my name for this topic.
- In middle 1996, Prof.SR delivered a talk at a Seminar on "Neural Network" at CSIR, Madras Complex. I shared the same dais for delivering my talk on 'Fuzzy Based PID Controller'
- In 2008 at CDAC, Trivandrum in ASTeC seminar I delivered a talk on 'Infection Point in Industrial Automation.' Prof. SR was the Session Chairman & Keynote Speaker for one of the Technical Sessions.
- I was truly humbled when I was asked to be the Chief Guest for one of the functions in Rrase Engineering College in July, 2018 by Prof. SR. He was quick to recognize talent and to make use of all available opportunities to elevate his meritorious students to the strong positions. He derived great satisfaction in that act.

When he was guiding one of his PhD students in an ambitious project for developing Boiler Performance Simulation Software, he gladly involved me to get the Boiler Design Data from BHEL & the Boiler Performance Data from NLC. I arranged the design data through my BHEL colleague & performance data from my MIT classmate Mr. T. Narayanan of NLC.

Prof. SR has truly played different memorable roles in my career – as Teacher, as Coach & as Mentor.

Time goes so fast! Life demands so much! No wonder great persons who helped me so dearly during my formative years get out of touch as time gallops! But in the heart deep memories stay forever, refreshing happy bygone moments that we had shared!


