6. Not Enough Marketing

You can have the best product or service in the world, but if nobody knows about it, you won't succeed. You need to get your name out there and let people know about the benefits of your business. If you cannot reach your audience, you cannot find success.

One of the most effective forms of marketing is word-of-mouth marketing. It's a form of advertising that comes directly from satisfied customers. Why does it work so well? Most consumers will believe a recommendation from a good friend or family member much faster than any ad or marketing strategy.

7. Poor Planning

We have all heard the saying, "If you fail to plan, you plan to fail." The absence of proper planning leads to subpar execution. A good business plan need not be overly complicated. It is as simple as knowing and developing a strategy around your company, your product and your competition.

8. Not Accepting Constructive Criticism

Let criticism serve as an opportunity to do it better. Too often, entrepreneurs get offended by critiques because they are too emotional when it comes to their business. There is no such thing as success without failure and mistakes. As an entrepreneur, you must find the lesson and learn from criticism.

9. Not Delegating

11. Burnout

As Lori Greiner of Shark Tank said, "Entrepreneurs are the only people who will work 80 hours a week to avoid working 40 hours a week."

There are plenty of reasons new businesses fail. From the common reasons listed above to a host of other situations, starting a new business and scaling for the long-term is not easy. That said, when business owners understand the reasons why businesses fail, they can be better prepared to avoid the pitfalls and navigate their way to a long and fruitful journey through entrepreneurship.



In B.Tech degree final year syllabus at MIT, Chennai we had a paper for which *_Control Engineering - Nagrath and Gopal_* was the prescribed book. In that book the authors start with a

history behind the automation.

Our temples.

Ancient Greek philosopher, mathematician and mechanic - Heron of Alexandria, helped the authorities to establish their supreme power over the people through magical (automation) power in the temples.

The temple doors - huge and heavy - were automatically opened though pneumatic (air) and hydraulic mechanisms.

Fire ritual (Yagna) was performed in front of the doors. As more and more ghees poured on altar (vedee, பீடம்) the high heat energy operated the hot air and water. The counter balance mechanism lifted an indicator. As the indicator reached a height the king joined the prayer and poured more ghee. The doors opened automatically. The people believed in supreme power of the king to open the heavy door just by prayers.

Not only the doors, to suppress mechanical sounds, Heron made automatic music played as the door opened. That was replaced by hanging bells on the doors.

Heron also designed an automated mechanism to disperse holy water to people who come to see the magical power of authorities. He designed an automatic small fire light (aarthi) inside the sanctum, which remained dark.

In ancient days, while Science fought with philosophers with theory and study of nature - we the engineers re-established the magical power of the philosophers through automation and engineering design.


